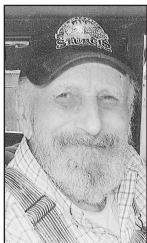


Vladimir A. Krocak

Vladimir Albert Krocak, 94, of Montgomery, passed away Friday, Sept. 13, 2013, at Three Links Care Center in Northfield. Visitation will be held on Thursday, Sept. 19, 2013, from 4 to 8 p.m. at the Schoenbauer Funeral Home in Montgomery.
